the other for **best artwork**

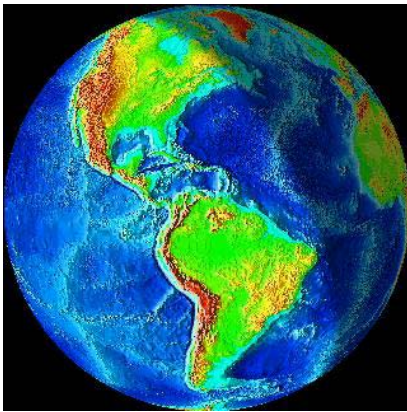
Grade Categories:
